Pain Medication Policy

We will provide pain medication for up to <u>90 days after surgery</u> or up to <u>30 days</u> <u>following an acute injury</u>. If surgery is scheduled but has not been performed, <u>we will not provide pain medication until after the surgery</u>. If you are within the abovementioned parameters and you need a refill on your pain medication, please read carefully.

Prescription refill process:

- *Prescriptions will be written out and ready for pick up on FRIDAYS.
- *You must notify us NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY of that week.
- *Please call prior to coming in on Friday to ensure your prescription was approved
- *Prescriptions cannot be mailed.

Please note that prescriptions will not be filled if:

- *you have exceeded the number of tablets as indicated in the directions.
- *If it was lost or stolen unless you have filed a formal police report and provide copy
- *If you receive pain medication from another office or provider

Any violation of this pain policy will result in us discontinuing the medication and may constitute dismissal from our clinic
